This tricot is made from **NYLON**. It is intended for **AERIAL** use. It has been destruction tested and proof tested for strength. However, it is easily damaged by sharp edges and has **A LOW MELTING POINT**.

Here are some important things to remember while using the fabric:

- **ALWAYS** check the edges for cuts or tears. A small tear on the edge can cause a catastrophic failure of the fabric.
- **AVOID** slack drops on communal silks and in classes. Slack drops create the most speed and heat and therefore the most damage.
- **DO NOT** wear jewellery, zippers or bras with hooks on the straps.
- **DO NOT** use the silks with long nails or acrylic nails.
- **DO NOT** wear nylon clothing, especially tights. Contact between the two materials during drops will accelerate heat production and cause burns in the fabric.
- **DO NOT** make knots in the fabric. It will weaken the fabric.
- **DO NOT** pull wraps or belay loops out with speed.
- **DO NOT** machine dry, dry clean or expose to heat, chemicals, bleach, printing processes or direct sunlight.
- **DO** resin the fabric well before use and regularly throughout its life. Resin and a light spray of grip spray will slow down users and reduce heat production.
- **DO** take care when opening maillons to avoid pinching the fabric in the screwgate.

Ultimately this product **IS FABRIC**, NOT steel. Like any other fabric, it **WILL** get holes, burns and other wear and tear. Trix Circus ensures that your product leaves our establishment in perfect condition, we are NOT liable or responsible for any damage that occurs in transit or during use.
